Message from Mrs Chatterjee

We've recently noticed an increase in litter around the school grounds and local area. As a school community, we are committed to taking positive action to address this issue and instil a sense of responsibility and environmental awareness in our children. On Monday, we will be having a special assembly, during which our Eco-Council will be presenting to Key Stage 2. They will be encouraging all children to take part in a new litter-picking initiative, which will not only help clean up our environment but also earn house points for their efforts. Children will be able to borrow litter pickers from school office for a couple of days before returning them. We are asking children to leave the litter at public bins or use their own bins (please don't bring it into school). It would be great if adults could take a photograph of the litter collected and send it in to school email (office@clarendon.bolton.sch.uk) with the child's name and class and then we are able to reward the children with house points for their efforts. We would love to see families getting involved together. We ask that parents accompany and supervise their children while litter picking and advise them on what is safe or appropriate to collect.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support in helping our children become thoughtful, active citizens. Together, we can make a real difference around our local area!

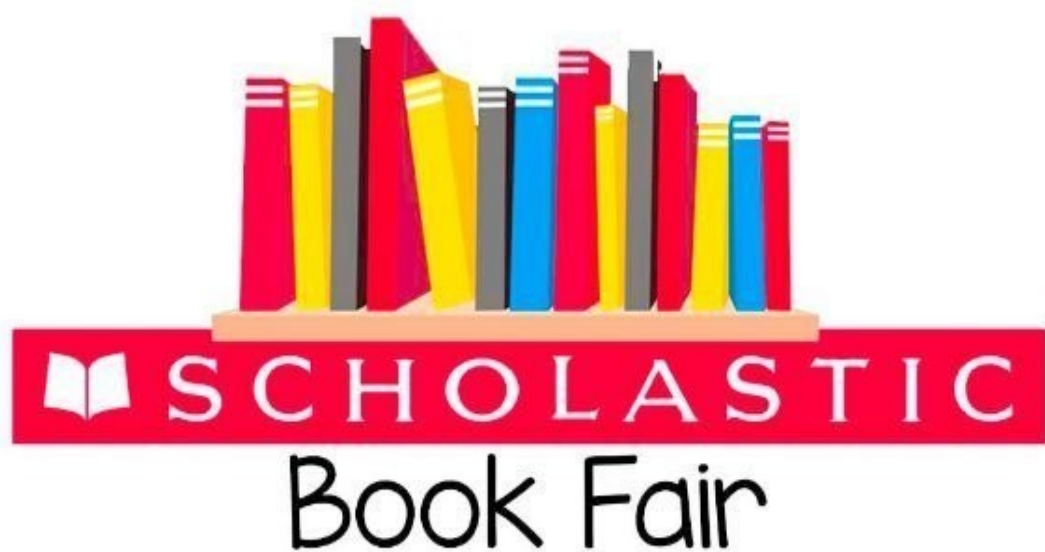
