Message from Mrs Chatterjee



This week leaders in school have been observing in classes. We have been really impressed with the way our children approach their learning. In February we have Parents Evening and I'm sure that when you attend these meetings: you too will be really pleased with the work in your children's books.

During these early stages, children develop essential skills such as communication, confidence, independence, and how to build positive relationships with others. We also have a strong speech and language offer for our children. Through play-based learning, we help them to begin to understand routines, manage emotions, and develop early literacy and numeracy in a fun and supportive environment.
