These can be purchased from the office at [morning breaktime only from next Monday \(8th December\)](#)

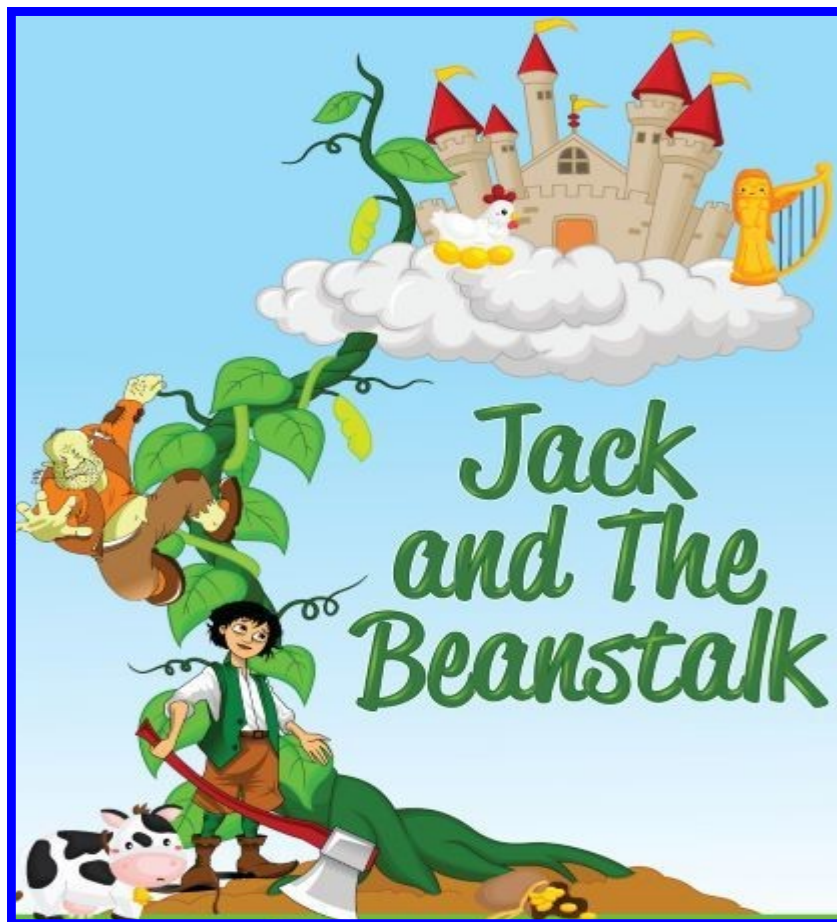
