There are also children accessing Call of Duty and Grand Theft Auto. Whilst we will speak to the children in school about the dangers associated with these games we can't oversee what games they are on at home. Please speak to the children about this and ensure that you are monitoring what they are playing online.

We have a Safeguarding section on our website. This has information on about how we process data from external bodies—such as the Police (operation Encompass).

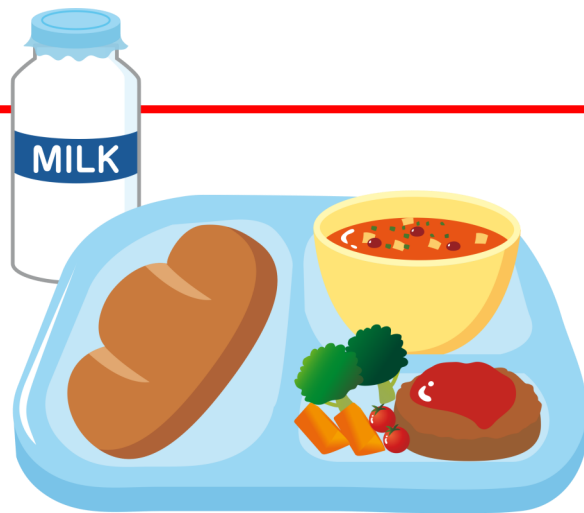
CHANGES TO LUNCHTIME MEAL OPTIONS
