Message from Mrs Chatterjee

We have had so many trips and visits taking place in the past two weeks and I wanted to let parents know just how exceptional the children's behaviour has been on these. A highlight for me was when we were in London with our Y6 children. A member of the public said that she teaches in America and would never dream of taking her secondary school children on such a busy trip—she couldn't believe just how well behaved our children were and said they are a credit to the school and parents...they really are. Thanks to all the staff who enable these visits to take place, without their time and dedication they would not go ahead...we really do have a wonderful team.

Last week we invited our Governors into school for our annual Governors Day. I wanted to pass on from the Governors how pleased they were with what they saw on the day. We had several groups of children presenting to Governors on the roles and responsibilities they have in school...& they were impressed with what they were told.

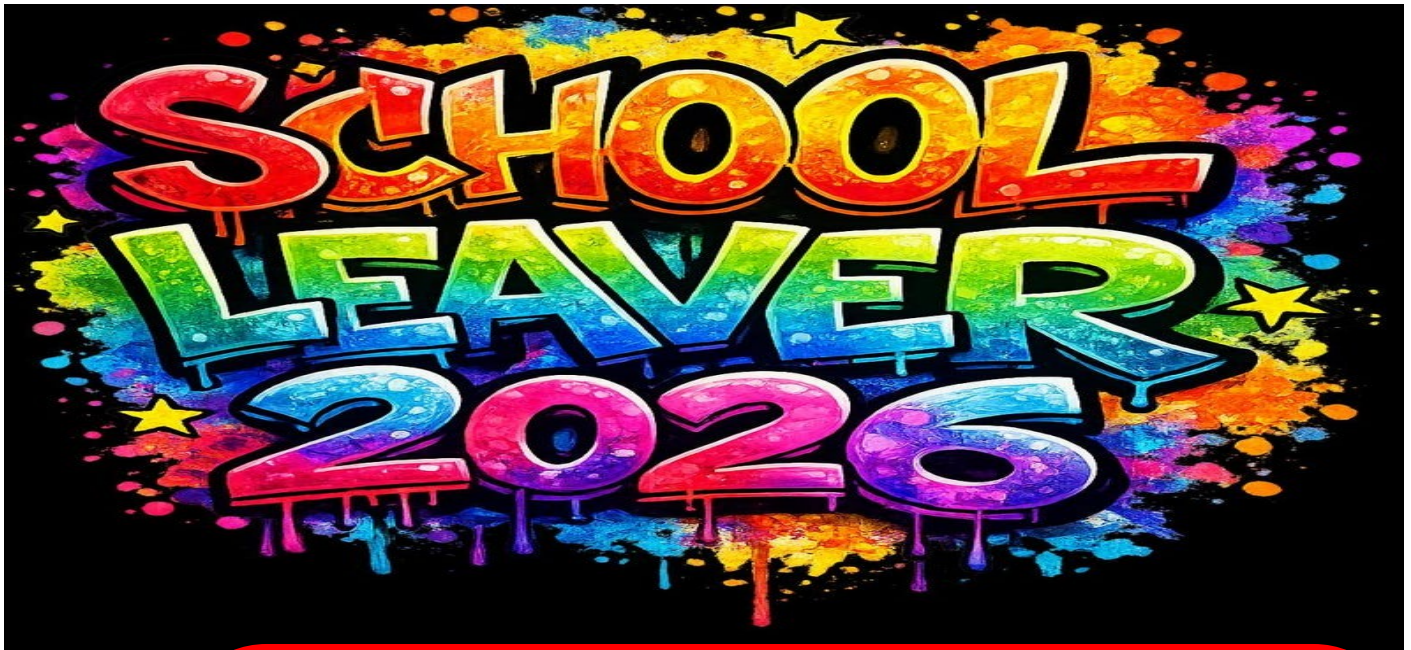
