Polite reminder to all parents that any changes to school dinners must be made via the school office.

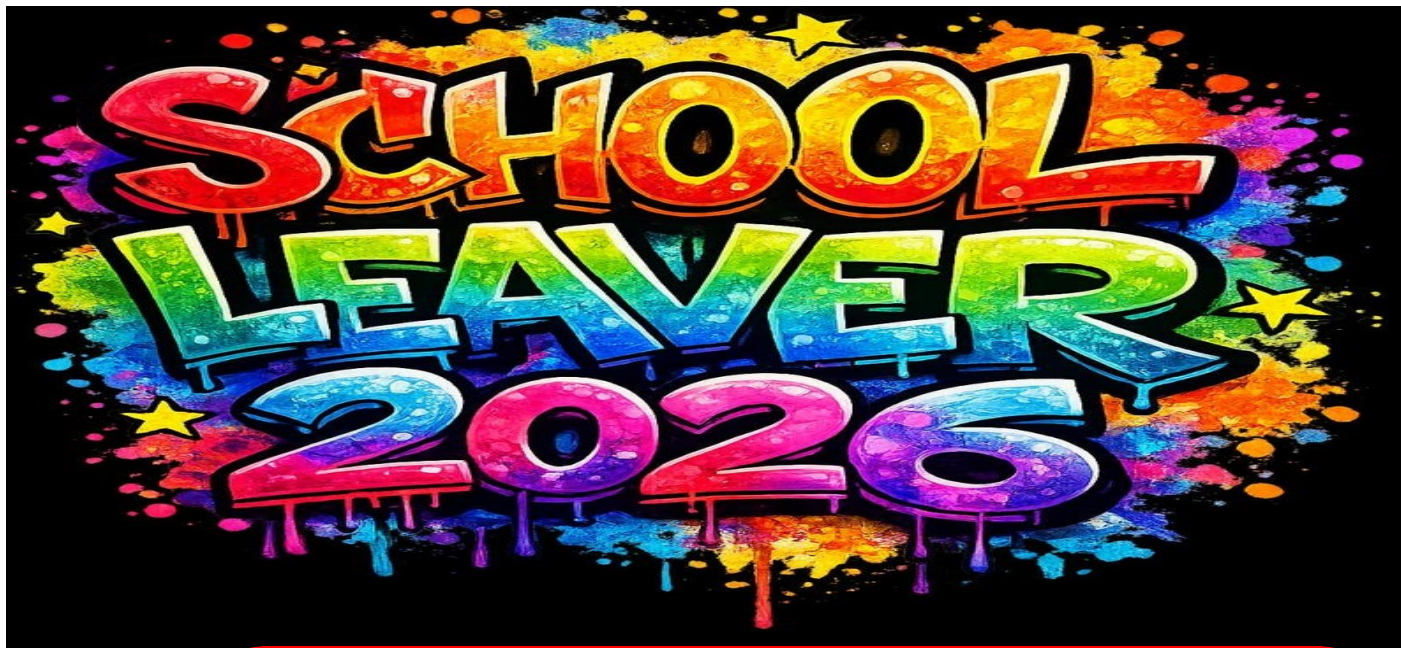
If your child would like to change from school dinners to pack lunches or packed lunches to school dinners please come to the office to inform us.
